CONSTRUCTION QUALITY MANAGEMENT CLASS FOR CONTRACTORS

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Louisville District, in partnership with the Naval Facilities Engineering Command and the AGC, West Central Ohio Division which is *DBA* Construction Builders Association of Ohio offers the Construction Quality Management for Contractors training in Dayton, Ohio.

US Army Corps of Engineers Requirements:

The US Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) requires all contractors performing construction compliance with the "Contractor Quality Control" (CQC), provisions in their contracts. In the early development of the CQC system, there was considerable misunderstanding as to what was required and who was responsible for it. In cooperation with the construction industry, the Corps developed a training course entitled "Construction Quality Management for Contractors (CQM)". The purpose of this course is to familiarize all quality management personnel with the Corps construction quality management policies and procedures. The course details the requirements of the government and contractor personnel assigned to the project and the reasons for those requirements. The effectiveness of the CQM system is enhanced when all personnel are aware of their responsibilities and the reasons for them. To ensure the success of the CQC system, every Corps construction contract stipulates that the contractor's quality control representative is required to have this training. This course is offered throughout the year by many Corps offices and contractor associations across the nation.

The certificate issued upon successful completion of CQM training is good for 5 years.

USACE CQM in Dayton, OH Training:

On a bi-monthly basis, the Construction Builders Association facilitates a CQM training session in Dayton, Ohio for the US Army Corps of Engineers, Louisville District. Typically, CQM classes are offered in February, April, June, August, October, and December, on Tuesday and Wednesday, 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM, in the second or third week of these months.

A Certified Instructor of the US Army Corps of Engineers provides CQM training using video, lecture, and individual/group work. All participants are issued a training manual, developed by the US Army Corps of Engineers and the US Naval Facilities Engineering Command.

A course certificate will be awarded to those who successfully complete the training and pass a final exam. The certificate is valid for a five-year period from the date of the class.

All Quality Control Representatives new to the CQC system are required to complete CQM for Contractors #784. Currently, all persons needing recertification must also attend CQM training.

CQM Training will be held at Shook Construction's Conference Room located at 2000 W. Dorothy Lane, Moraine, OH 45439. If lodging is needed, the following are convenient options:

USACE CQM Training in Dayton, OH Continued:

The fee for CQM for Contractors training is \$250/person for Construction Builders Association members; and \$400/person for all others. The fee covers course materials, completion certificate, and continental breakfast, lunch, and refreshments on both class days.

Registration and payment are required to participate in the US Army Corps of Engineers Construction Quality Management for Contractors training hosted by the Construction Builders Association:

- Completed CQM Registration forms are to be forwarded to the CBA by email to drhodes@agcofdayton.com or US Postal Service to hold a seat in the class.
- Check payments should be made out to the Construction Builders Association and mailed to POB 341508, Beavercreek, OH 45434 and received by the Friday preceding the start of CQM training.
- Credit card payments can be accepted; however, the Construction Builders Association will charge an additional \$15 transaction fee per participant.
- Once payment is received, participants will be notified registration in CQM training is confirmed.
- A completion certificate will be held for any participant who satisfies training requirements however, his/her class fee is unpaid at the end of training. The certificate will be mailed to the participant once payment is finalized.
- It is understood a conflict may arise preventing a registered CQM participant from attending scheduled class, however, a course refund will not be issued. Registration and payment can be deferred until a future CQM class, preferably in the same fiscal year; or a CQM registration/payment can be assigned to another person within the same Company.

CQM for Contractors Class Information

- ❖ All Quality Control Representatives new to the Contractor Quality Control system and those needing recertification are required to complete a CQM for Contractors #784.
- ❖ The Construction Builders Association partnered with the US Army Corps of Engineers, Louisville District to provide CQM training in Dayton, bi-monthly.
- ❖ A US Army Corps of Engineers Certified Instructor provides CQM training.
- ❖ CQM for Contractor training is held over a two-day period, typically on a Tuesday and Wednesday, 8 AM – 3 PM at 2000 W. Dorothy Lane, Moraine 45439.
- ❖ The fee for CQM training is \$250/person for Construction Builders Association members; and \$400/person for all others. The fee covers training materials, completion certificate, and continental breakfast, lunch, and refreshment service on both class days.
- ❖ Forward a completed CQM registration form to drhodes@agcofdayton.com to hold a seat in a CQM class.
- ❖ Mail check payment to the Construction Builders Association, P.O. Box 341508, Beavercreek, OH 45434; or call to arrange for a credit card payment with \$15/each fee.
- ❖ Receipt of payment is requested prior to the start of CQM class. Once payment is received, CQM class registration will be confirmed via email.
- ❖ Follow-up CQM information will be e-mailed to all class participants, as needed.
